POLICY

Export control laws, implemented by the United States as well as many other countries, are designed to protect national security interests, prevent terrorism and stem the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. In general, these laws determine *what* can be exported, *to whom* it can be exported, for *what use* it can be exported and whether *prior approval* from the host-country government (in the form of an export license) is required before the export or re-export takes place.

SDV Recon, Inc is committed to compliance with applicable export control laws. These laws affect aspects of SDV Recon's business operations including product sales, shipping and customer interactions abroad.

SDV Recon, Inc has implemented procedures to support compliance with export control laws.

It is the responsibility of all SDV Recon managers and employees to prevent any export, re-export, sale, transfer of technology, or other activity that may violate these laws.

VIOLATIONS

Failure to comply with these regulations may subject SDV Recon, Inc to substantial penalties, fines, denial of exporting privileges and criminal prosecution.
